The CRPF Public School, Jawahar Nagar is a Co-educational Day- cum Residential Higher Secondary School with an enrollment of 2084 (CRPF WARDS-997, CIVIL WARDS – 1035) students from classes UKG to XII. The school aims to become a 'Center for Excellence', providing quality education for India's deserving young minds, empowering them to be courageous, confident and self-disciplined.
