ANNUAL REPORT - 2022-23

The mission of the CRPF Public School is," to function as a pace setting institution and provide quality education to the wants of force personnel and civilians." The school strives to innovate and experiment new methods and strategies of teaching to make learning a joyful experience. The school aims to become a 'center for excellence', providing quality education for deserving young minds, empowering them to be courageous, confident and self-disciplined.

The school took shape in the year 1996, when the CRPI Employees Educational Society, New Delhi, felt the need to establish a school in south India to cater to the educational needs of the wards of the CRPI personnel. Since then it has grown by leaps and bounds from 35 students and 3 teachers to 2136 students and 75 teachers today.

It is my privilege to present the annual report of 2022-23.Let us begin with academics. I take pride to report that the results for the year 2021-22 were excellent. We achieved 100 percent results in both X and XII with good subject averages. This was possible by the continuous and combined effort put in by our dedicated staff.

Academics and Examinations All examinations whether they are periodic tests or the term end exams are based on the board pattern, students are prepared for the boards right from class VI. They are given continuous practice and revision. All CBSE guidelines and directions related to academics, curricular and co-curricular activities are followed and practiced. The school has designed its curriculum in accordance with the National education policy (NEP). We are also considering the LEAD curriculum and the ELGA books for the next academic year. It's a moment of pride for our school that it has been appointed as the Lead Collaborator by CBSE for 7 other schools of the nearby areas, which is a remarkable achievement.

School Assemblies students are encouraged to speak and polish their knowledge and speaking abilities through regular participation in assemblies. They are informed about important national and international days and events through various activities conducted in the assembly.

Medical checkups: This year the students from classes 6^{th} to 10^{th} were administered the COVID vaccine in two phases. The students of classes 10^{th} and 5^{th} were given the tetanus injection.

Guidance and counseling: The school Councilor regularly counsels children and offers professional guidance and counseling programs. Students with learning disabilities are identified and referred to the NIMH for tests and follow-ups

Primary School: I thank the management for sanctioning the construction work of the primary and the secondary school. The primary school was shifted to the barracks in August this year, for which we are extremely thankful to the management as it has ensured a smooth functioning of the primary school without any hindrance. Our primary school functioned as usual with its fun filled activities. No bag day is followed on Saturday where students learn life lessons and problem solving skills through a plethora of activities like art and crafts, no fire cooking, show and tell presentations which imbibes conceptual learning, celebration of days like blue day, red day, storytelling sessions etc. In accordance with CBSE guidelines students are being taught as per the FLN and SAFAL. In accordance with the state government directions, this year telugu is introduced as the 2nd language from class 1 onwards.

Ayrabhatta Ganit Challenge - 443 appeared, results awaited. CBSE Reading Challenge - 460 students appeared, as per CBSE guidelines 20 students were sent for the 2nd level. Four students from our school earned accolades and a cash prize of Rs 6000 each in The Deen Dayal Sparsh Yojana -A quiz, organized by the Postal Department of India at the Nizam College, Hyderabad.
